

Abstract

There is a pathetic situation that the government of Sri Lanka does not take over the preschools. So the preschools are conducted by a number of institutions. Taking into consideration of these institutions follow different curricula, the Children Secretariat of the Ministry of Women Affairs has published a Curriculum for the preschool teachers named 'Earlier Childhood Growth' as a guide book with the sponsorship of Save the Children Fund in 2007. In this book the curricula of Language development, Physical development, Intellectual development, Creative development and Social Emotional development are included and the activities to implement these aspects are clearly shown.

There are 84 registered preschools In Trincomalee educational division. All these schools follow the above said curricula. Productivity of the children can be achieved only if these curricula are implemented through suitable and appropriate ways. An survey 'Evaluation of the Productivity on the aspects of the Curricula followed by the preschools of Trincomalee Educational Division' was conducted by the researcher to present for recommendation and also to evaluate the productivity and the factors for them.

Thirty preschools and the teachers of those schools and the Additional Director for preschools were considered as research samples. By using the research tools such as questionnaire, interview and observation the data were collected and by using Survey method evaluation was done. On that basis, when the skills that students should achieve were evaluated individually the results were not satisfactory. And the researcher presented the possible practical ways to increase the productivity.
